

APPLYING FOR UNIVERSITY HIGHER EDUCATION WEEK




Each year, for a week in July, students abandon their normal teaching timetable to engage in Destinations Week – University. Key universities deliver presentation on how to apply, which course to choose, city or campus university, as well as the all-important talks on university finance.

Students participate in university workshops, supported by key school staff. Students are shown how to navigate their way around the UCAS website, as well as how to complete the UCAS application form. There are taught sessions on writing the personal statement, as well as a weekly timetabled lesson throughout the first term of year 13 to support the timely completion of the university application and ensure that student references are the best that they can be.

Students are encouraged to be aspirational as well as realistic when applying for university. It is this approach which has led to all Year 13 students leaving Brook 6th Form & Academy with an excellent university of their choice, to complete incredibly impressive degrees ranging from Aerospace Engineering to Biomedical Sciences.

APPRENTICESHIP WEEK



The focus on apprenticeships begins from the start, with the first apprenticeship talk delivered by employers within the first 6 weeks of the students course. Whilst we are aware that the majority of students still wish to complete the traditional route and progress to university, we provide all students with the same information so that they are able to make an informed choice. Most employers deliver in-person presentations, although a few still to choose deliver remotely. Employers share information regarding what an apprenticeship entails, as well as how to complete a strong apprenticeship applicant. A number of employers bring along current apprentices to the talks, so that the students can hear and learn from other young people not too dissimilar from themselves in age and background.

SIXTH FORM OPEN EVENING AND FUTURE DESTINATIONS EVENT

Each year in November Brook 6th Form & Academy hosts a Sixth Form Open Evening with a difference. Current students attend the evening to meet university representatives as well as local and national employers who host a stand at the event and provide key information about their university and company. Future students are invited to learn about Sixth Form course choices as well as opportunities that will be available to them if they complete a sixth form course at Brook 6th Form & Academy. This unique event is well attended with 100's of young people attending each year.
