APPLYING FOR UNIVERSITY HIGHER EDUCATION WEEK

Each July, Year 12 students take part in Destinations Week – University, with leading universities offering guidance on applications, course choices, and student finance. Through workshops and continued support, Brook 6th Form & Academy helps every student complete strong UCAS applications and secure places on ambitious degree courses.

Students interested in Medicine receive focused support with their applications, including advice on personal statements, admissions tests, and interview preparation.



APPLYING FOR APPRENTICESHIPS

At Brook 6th Form & Academy, we introduce students to apprenticeship pathways early on through engaging talks from industry employers. These sessions, held both in person and online, provide valuable insight into the world of apprenticeships and practical advice on applications. Students also hear directly from current apprentices and alumni, gaining real-life perspectives on balancing work, study, and career development. This early exposure helps students understand the wide range of opportunities available, build confidence in their choices, and take clear, informed steps toward their future careers.



DEDICATED SUPPORT FOR YEAR 13 DESTINATIONS

INDIVIDUAL GUIDANCE

In Year 13, students receive dedicated support to help them plan their next steps – whether that’s university, an apprenticeship, or employment. Staff are available to offer:

- Guidance on university and apprenticeship options
- Support with applications and personal statements
- Help with CVs, interviews, and presentation skills
- Encouragement to reflect on aspirations and make informed choices
- Direct exposure to apprenticeship pathways through engaging insights from industry employers
- A wide range of opportunities to explore post-18 pathways including careers fairs, employer engagement and alumni talks

Our team works closely with each student to ensure they feel confident and ready for their next stage.

Students also benefit from regular meetings with pastoral staff throughout the year. These may be informal chats or structured sessions designed to help them:
