

Dear Parents/Carers and Students,

I am writing to update you on our arrangements in response to the extreme weather conditions forecast for this week.

The region is currently under amber weather alerts for Tuesday 23rd, Thursday 25th and Friday 26th June, with a red weather alert in place for Wednesday 24th June.


As a result, **Wednesday 24th June will be a Blended Learning Day**. The school will be closed to all students and staff, and everyone will work remotely from home. Students should register online at **8:30am**, attend **Lessons 1–4 remotely**, and the school day will end at **1:30pm**.

Any **Milestone Assessments, MA3**, planned for Wednesday 24th June will now take place on **Wednesday 1st July**. Timings will remain the same.

On **Thursday 25th and Friday 26th June**, the school will open in the morning so that MA3 assessments can continue as planned. The school day will finish at **11:45am for students** and **12:00 noon for staff**, allowing everyone to travel home before the peak temperatures of the day. **Lesson 5 will be delivered remotely**, and all students must register online at **2:00pm** so we can confirm they have returned home safely.

Thank you for your understanding and cooperation as we respond sensibly to the unusual weather conditions while continuing to support teaching, learning and assessment.
